The application period for the Professional Fellows Program (PFP) on Citizen Participation in Government for applicants from Israel is **now open**. The PFP is sponsored by the United States Department of State with funding provided by the U.S. Government, and administered by the Institute for Training and Development based in Amherst, Massachusetts.

This two-way exchange program is designed for young professionals to enhance their leadership and professional skills, build sustainable partnerships with U.S. professional hosts, and gain a deeper understanding of civic engagement practices in the United States.
