### ***Eligibility Requirements***

- Candidates must be Palestinian residents of Jerusalem, Gaza, or the West Bank;
- Possess a college degree;
- Have 2-10 years of professional experience;
- Demonstrate a high proficiency in English in the interview process;
- Be no older than 35;
- Be committed to a 12-18 month virtual Fellowship;
- Ideal candidates will have experience or demonstrated interest in addressing critical social issues.

### ***Deadline to Apply***

Atlas Corps accepts applications year-round, but the priority deadline to be considered for 2021 Fellowships is **October 23, 2020**. Early applications are encouraged.
